Androy motioned to approve the special meeting agenda. Breeding seconded. All ayes; motion carried.

Moreau introduced review and discussion on the Proposed FY20 Malvern City Budget Amendment #2; whereupon McGann motioned to set the public hearing date for March 16, 2020, at City Hall, 100 West 5th Street, Malvern, at 7 p.m. Breeding seconded. All ayes; motion carried.

Moreau introduced review and discussion on the Proposed FY 21 Final Budget; whereupon Androy set the public hearing date for March 16, 2020, at City Hall, 100 West 5th Street, Malvern, at 7 p.m. Breeding seconded. All ayes; motion carried.

Moreau introduced review of Marion Avenue Bridge Replacement 8th Periodic Cost Estimate (PCE) for \$67,767.29. Poort conducted a current review of revenues and expenses for engineering and construction noting BNSF contribution, IDOT reimbursements, City costs, general obligations bond for P&D engineering, and flagging costs contributing to the financial picture. McGann motioned to approve PCE#8 for \$67,767.29, with a second from Shere. All ayes; motion carried.

Moreau introduced non-agenda items with no action to be taken. An email thread was reviewed regarding concerns with interim funding and steps to follow with bond counsel and 1^{st} National financial team.

Androy motioned to adjourn. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:36 p.m.
