

MALVERN CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
Malvern City Hall – 100 W 5th Street

The May 20, 2024 special meeting of the Malvern City Council was **called to order** by Mayor Douglas Shere at 7:00 p.m. Council members present were Chris Androy, Bryan Rasmussen, Amber Lidgett, and Heather West. Also in attendance were John Jorgenson and Joe George. Mayor Shere recognized visitors seeking to address the Council; none being present. West motioned to approve the **Consent Agenda** consisting of the May 20, 2024 tentative Council meeting agenda. Seconded by Lidgett. Lidgett, Rasmusen, Androy, and West voted aye; motion carried.

New Business: Mayor Shere called a **public hearing** to order at 7:01 p.m. regarding the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the proposed 2024 W 9th Street & E 15th Street Reconstruction project. Shere recognized the publication of the notice of public hearing in the Malvern Leader on May 16, 2024. City Clerk reported no written or verbal objections filed at City Hall. John Jorgenson presented the final engineering plans for the project to Council. Mayor Shere adjourned the public hearing at 7:02 p.m. Androy motioned to approve **Resolution 2024-16**-approving and confirming plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the 2024 W 9th Street and E 15th Street Reconstruction Project. Seconded by Lidgett. Rasmussen, Lidgett, Androy, and West voted aye; motion carried. Councilwoman submitted her letter of resignation to the Council. Androy will resign from Council effective June 30, 2024 and cited her increasing involvement in Iowa Concerns of Police Survivors and her obligation to the organization as her reason for resigning. Androy has served on Malvern City Council since January 2018. Lidgett motioned to **adjourn** the meeting at 7:11 p.m. Seconded by West. Androy, Lidgett, West, and Rasmussen voted aye; motion carried.
